

Multiplications Word Problems

(Grade-2)

Do the following problems:

- 1) There are 5 rows of chairs in a classroom. Each row has 9 chairs. How many chairs are there in total?
- 2) A box contains 8 packs of crayons. Each pack has 10 crayons. How many crayons are there in total?
- 3) A farmer has 3 fields. Each field has 9 cows. How many cows are there in all the fields?
- 4) There are 8 boxes of cookies, and each box contains 15 cookies. How many cookies are there in all the boxes?
- 5) There are 7 days in a week, and each day has 24 hours. How many hours are there in a week?

6) A farmer has 8 baskets. Each basket contains 15 eggs. How many eggs are there in all the baskets?

7) A pet store has 9 aquariums. Each aquarium has 9 fish. How many fish are there in all the aquariums?

8) There are 9 shelves in a library, and each shelf has 18 books. How many books are there in the library?

9) Olivia is making gift bags for a party. She wants to put 6 stickers in each bag and make 5 bags. How many stickers does she needs in total?

10) A toy store sells packs of 4 toy cars. If a customer buys 6 packs, how many toy cars do they get?
